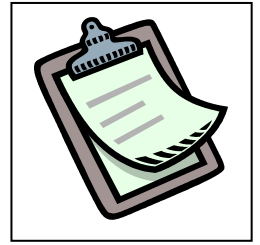

The missed science club will take place on Thursday 7 June.

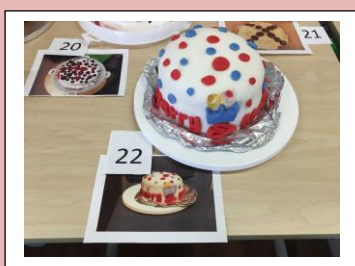
**KS2 Samba** – KS2 Samba will begin on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> June. If you would like your child to attend, then please pay on ParentPay.
